Hematopathologist – Diagnostic Services of Manitoba

Diagnostic Services of Manitoba is seeking applications for a full-time hematopathologist. This is a new position. Commencement date is as soon as possible.

The successful applicant will be based at the Hematopathology Laboratories of the University of Manitoba affiliated Hospitals, Saint Boniface General and Health Sciences Centre, in Winnipeg. The successful candidate will join a practice group that provides comprehensive diagnostic hematopathology and transfusion services to the Province of Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario.

Primary duties will include general hematopathology, neoplastic and non-neoplastic, as well as transfusion medicine services, in support of various tertiary care programs, and a provincial referral program. Participation in molecular hematology, or flow cytometry/immunology services will be encouraged. There is opportunity for engaging in hematology and transfusion medicine related clinical research. Candidates will be expected to take part in the teaching of postgraduate and undergraduate students, and to hold an appointment in the University of Manitoba Department of Pathology.

Candidates must have the pertinent specialty qualifications in the country of current practice and must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Acceptable certifications include Hematological Pathology, Anatomical, General Pathology, or equivalent, with additional hematopathology and transfusion training. Hematopathology qualification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada is preferred.

Applications are encouraged from qualified women and men, including members of visible minorities, Aboriginal peoples and persons with disabilities. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.

Application materials, including letters of reference, will be handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (Manitoba).

Applications will be reviewed and accepted until the position is filled.

Salary and benefits will be commensurate with qualifications. DSM thanks all applicants who express interest in this competition. Only those selected for an interview will be contacted.
